The scholarships are to be applied toward the purchase of a registered Hampshire breeding ewe or ewe lamb at the Minnesota Bred Ewe Sale in River Falls, WI, Saturday, November 30, 2019. ### Minutes of Summer Meeting Sat., Aug. 17, 2019, Fairmont, MN

Meeting called to order by President Rodney Scheller at 1:10 PM

Martin County Fair Board members reminded members that 2019 is the 15<sup>th</sup> year the show has been held at Martin County. Board and members reviewed show features and future shows.

The show was reviewed by co-chairman Tom Bobendrier and Bob Koehler. The show was judged by Gene Sanford. Seventy five entries were exhibited by nine exhibitors. Champion ram was shown by Reid Merrill and Reserve Champion ram was shown by Bobendrier Boys. Champion Ewe was shown by Erin & Cole Luck. Reserve Champion Ewe was exhibited by Gary Klug. Premier Exhibitor was Ram'n Acres.

National Association report was given by director Tom Bobendrier. Tom discussed current national office activities and welcomes comments and suggestions regarding improving the services of the national Hampshire Association.

Discussion was held regarding the financial condition of the state association. In past years the Bred Ewe Sale contributed revenues to the association treasury, but recent year's lower revenues have resulted in lower treasury balances. A motion by Tom Underwood seconded by Tom Bobendrier and passed, to discontinue payment of state association sponsored class premiums paid to state fair 4-H Hampshire exhibitors and reduce Bred Ewe Sale scholarships from 5 to 3 awards.

Motion by Adam Benker, seconded by Chuck Bobendrier and passed, to give state fair 4-H Hampshire exhibitors a free annual membership for 2020.

State Fair 4-H Hamp Show Ewe Lamb and Yearling Ewe champions and reserve champion plaques will continue to be provided by the state association.

The Minnesota Hampshire Web site is managed by Dave Bobendrier. Members are urged to place promotional bred ewe sale information and pictures on the web site by contacting Dave Bobendrier.

Suggestions for the names of possible judges of the 2019 Bred Ewe Sale were received. The suggested names referred to the sale committee were Gene Sanford and Richard Krakow.

2019 Bred Ewe sale will be held at River Falls, Wisconsin on the Univ of Wisconsin campus. The sale will include registered and wether breeding ewes and ewe lambs and Boer goat doe entries.
